**What to bring - Montana Expedition:**

We will be fishing in a high mountain environment on big rivers and small streams. Weather can range drastically. Keep in mind we use an open drift boat and or jet boat in the morning when the air can be cold, even in the summer months. Being well prepared can make the difference between a successful trip and a cold uncomfortable one. Forget the forecast – you need layers!

Montana expeditions include all terminal fishing equipment, lunch, water, cooler with ice, boat launch and fuel fees. You are more than welcome to provide your own snacks and specialty drinks. Beer and wine is encouraged if desired. Please disclose any food allergies/diet restrictions ahead of time.

Depending on the rivers we fish, rental cars are recommended to get from the airport to your hotel accommodations. We fish all over southwest Montana. Uber and taxis are available in some towns but are much less convenient. The guide will contact you with a meeting place and time prior to your trip date.

CHECK LIST – be thoughtful of the items you bring

- Montana recreational fishing license [click here](#)
- Polarized sunglasses
- Favorite hat
- Lightweight long sleeve sun shirts
- Lightweight quick dry pants
- Warm base layers
- Wind breaker / Rain gear (a must!)
- Non skid wading shoes / sandals (minimal “knobby” tread)
- Waders and wading boots if desired
- Sunscreen of choice\*
- Bug spray of choice\*
- 5-7wt fly rod and reel with standard cold WF floating lines\*\*
- Lastly, and most important - bring a huge smile paired with a great attitude

\*Guide will have basic sunscreen and bug spray on hand

\*\* Guide will provide all terminal fishing tackle necessary for clients who do not possess certain items.
