

What to bring - Louisiana Expedition:

We will be fishing ocean side in a brackish fresh and saltwater environment. Weather can range drastically. Keep in mind we use an open boat running early in the morning when the air is damp and cold. Being well prepared can make the difference between a successful trip and a cold uncomfortable one. Forget the forecast – you need layers!

Louisiana expeditions include all terminal fishing equipment, lunch, water, cooler with ice, boat launch and fuel fees. You are more then welcome to provide your own snacks and specialty drinks. Beer and wine is encouraged if desired. Please disclose any food allergies/diet restrictions ahead of time.

Depending on your hotel accommodations, rental cars are recommended. Uber and taxis are available but much less convenient for the return trip to New Orleans (45 minutes). The guide will contact you with meeting times and locations prior to your trip. New Orleans is our home, we know the city and surrounding water very well. Any questions/recommendations regarding your upcoming trip, please let us know.

Favorite hat
Lightweight long sleeve sun shirts
Lightweight quick dry pants
Warm base layers
Wind breaker / Rain gear (a must!)
Non skid sneakers, NO hiking boots please (minimal "knobby" tread)
Sunscreen of choice*
Bug spray of choice*
8 -10wt fly rod and reel with cold WF floating lines**
Lastly, and most important - bring a huge smile paired with a great attitude
